(Please stand)

GOSPEL:

Priest: The Lord be with you.

Priest: A reading from the Holy Gospel according to [Matthew/Mark/Luke/John]
Response: Glory to you, O Lord.

After the Gospel:

Priest: The Gospel of the Lord.
Response: Praise to you Lord Jesus Christ.

After each petition:

Priest: Lord in your mercy
Response: Hear our prayer
